- What:** **US Lacrosse Officials Training Program, Women's Game.** Learn the rules and the basics of officiating this exciting Spring season game. **Classroom Clinics** run 6 hours. See options below. *Junior umpires are under 18 and in high school.* **Field Training (4 hours)** for Adults will take place on March 17th at Sunset HS in Beaverton. *TBD: Additional training in Eugene and Junior field training.* *Fee includes classroom and field training, Fox 40 whistle, flag (Adult), cards, and annual Oregon Women's Lacrosse Umpires Association membership. US Lacrosse membership as an official (\$35-50, includes rule book) is also required.*
